\*Prepares and submits weekly lesson plans for review by the Head of the Upper School.

\*Complies with all Valor policies and procedures and attends all required meetings including, but not limited to, parent conferences, faculty meetings, devotions, school functions and training.

\*Follows established guidelines for dealing with students, parents, administration, and staff; demonstrates support for the role of parents as primarily responsible before God for their child's education and assists them in that task.

\*Requires basic understanding of a comprehensive field of knowledge normally acquired through attainment of a Bachelor's degree or higher in related field; 3-5 years prior related experience preferred.

\*Must be a Christian who is, and will remain during the period of employment, an active member of a Christ-centered church, growing in his/her Christian relationship with God, and actively practicing and exhibiting Christian principles of the Christian faith.

\*Personally attuned to the requirements of meeting needs of the students and ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with parents, other employees, and the public; demonstrates the character qualities of enthusiasm, courtesy, flexibility, integrity, gratitude, kindness, self-control, perseverance, and punctuality.
